

HRDV16/8 (Formerly DVMS1600/800) Software Upgrading Using a PCMCIA Flash Card Application Note

Upgrade Procedure

Note Ensure **Auto Record** is enabled before starting this procedure (go to: **Menu ► System Setup ► User Preferences**).

1. Power off the HRDV by unplugging the power supply from the unit.
2. Insert the PCMCIA card with the upgrade file in the PCMCIA slot at the back of the unit. If there is another card already in the slot, remove it for the purpose of this upgrade.
3. Re-apply power to the HRDV.
4. Wait approximately 5 minutes for the software upgrade to complete. This will happen automatically, you do not need to do anything. As the software upgrade proceeds you will see a progress indication on the LCD display on the front of the unit. The HRDV will give messages about blocks being written and verified. When the process is complete the unit will begin beeping to indicate the upgrade is complete.

WARNING! During this process do not interrupt power to the unit, wait until the upgrade is complete.

5. Once the upgrade is complete and the unit is beeping, it is safe to continue the procedure.
6. Power off the HRDV.
7. Remove the PCMCIA Flash card from the rear of the unit.

Note If you removed a PCMCIA in step 2, re-insert it now.

8. Re-apply power to the HRDV, it will take approximately 2 minutes for the unit to reboot.

Note During this process the HRDV will perform a disk and data integrity check, in some cases the unit may need to rebuild video pointers. If this occurs, the process could take several hours. The unit will perform this process unattended and when complete put itself into record mode, provided **Auto Record** is enabled in **User Preferences**.

9. The Software upgrade is now complete. To verify the new version is installed:
 - a. Log on and go to: **Menu ► System Setup ► System Info.**
 - b. The new version will be displayed here.
 - c. Once verified, log off.
10. Verify the unit says Recording on the LCD display.
